



TICKETING, PARKING, AND MORE

Tickets are required to enter the temple campus for all High Holy Days services and programs.

Temple Partners

Temple partners in good standing may request tickets online for themselves and their children under age 30 at no cost at www.AdatElohim.org/HHDTickets. Have your username and password ready. *If you need assistance completing the request, please call the temple office at (805) 497-7101.*

Partner Guest Tickets

We warmly welcome additional family members and guests. Temple partners may bill these contributions to their temple account through Thursday, September 11, or pay by credit card. After September 11, account billing will no longer be available.

Tickets will be emailed from Orders@SimpleTickets.com approximately one week before Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Printing tickets is optional. When arriving at TAE for High Holy Days services, the QR code included in your email can be scanned.

Parking

RESTRICTED PARKING DURING FOUR SERVICES: Due to the limited number of parking spaces in the temple lot, parking passes will be issued to worshippers with medical needs or valid California State Disabled Parking Permits during the following services: Erev Rosh Hashanah, Rosh Hashanah Day Traditional Service, Kol Nidre (Erev Yom Kippur), and Yom Kippur Traditional Service. *If a parking pass is needed, please submit the request on the ticket order form.*

OFF-SITE PARKING: Parking will be available across the street at Conejo Valley Church of Christ (2525 E. Hillcrest Drive, Thousand Oaks, 91362). Please be careful when crossing the street. Additionally, parking will be available on neighboring streets. Please be respectful of our neighbors and do not block driveways or mailboxes.

Security Protocols

We take security seriously. As part of our enhanced safety measures, including extra guards and collaboration with law enforcement, we will require tickets to enter the campus during the High Holy Days. We also ask that you leave large bags at home, as all bags are subject to search.

Audio Assistance

The sanctuary has a loop system compatible with T-coil-equipped hearing aids. We also have a limited number of headsets to lend to worshippers in need of amplification.
