
Pirke Avot: More Wisdom From Our Sages

And if not now, then when?" -R Hillel. We will be using Sage Advice by Rabbi Yitzchak Greenberg as our primary textbook. However, any version of Pirke Avot is acceptable. In the 6th century BCE, Jeremiah lived in Judah and Ezekiel in Babylon. Did the two ever meet? There is nothing in the Bible to contradict this idea. Employing a themebased approach, this course will attempt to find out who they were. Did their backgrounds and personalities impact their understanding of prophecy, Torah, God, and the historical time in which they lived? What did they agree on and where did they differ? Through text, music, and art explore whether and how this is relevant to us today. **This course is designed by local faculty.**
